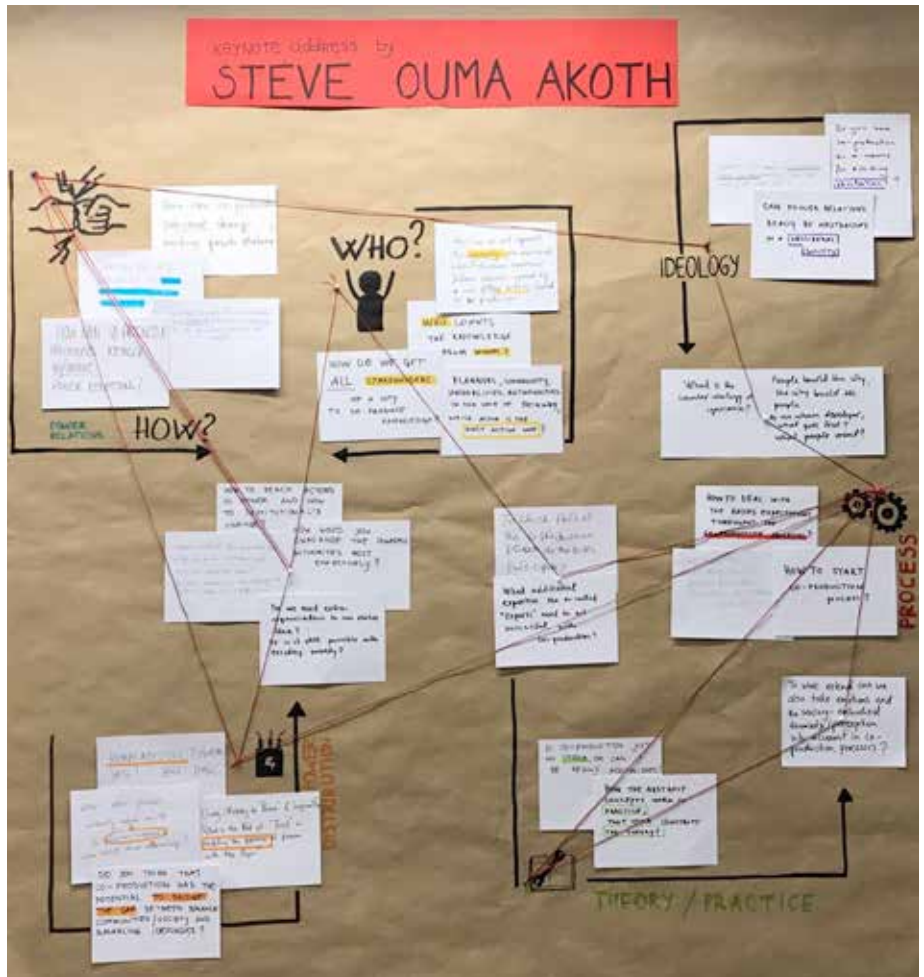

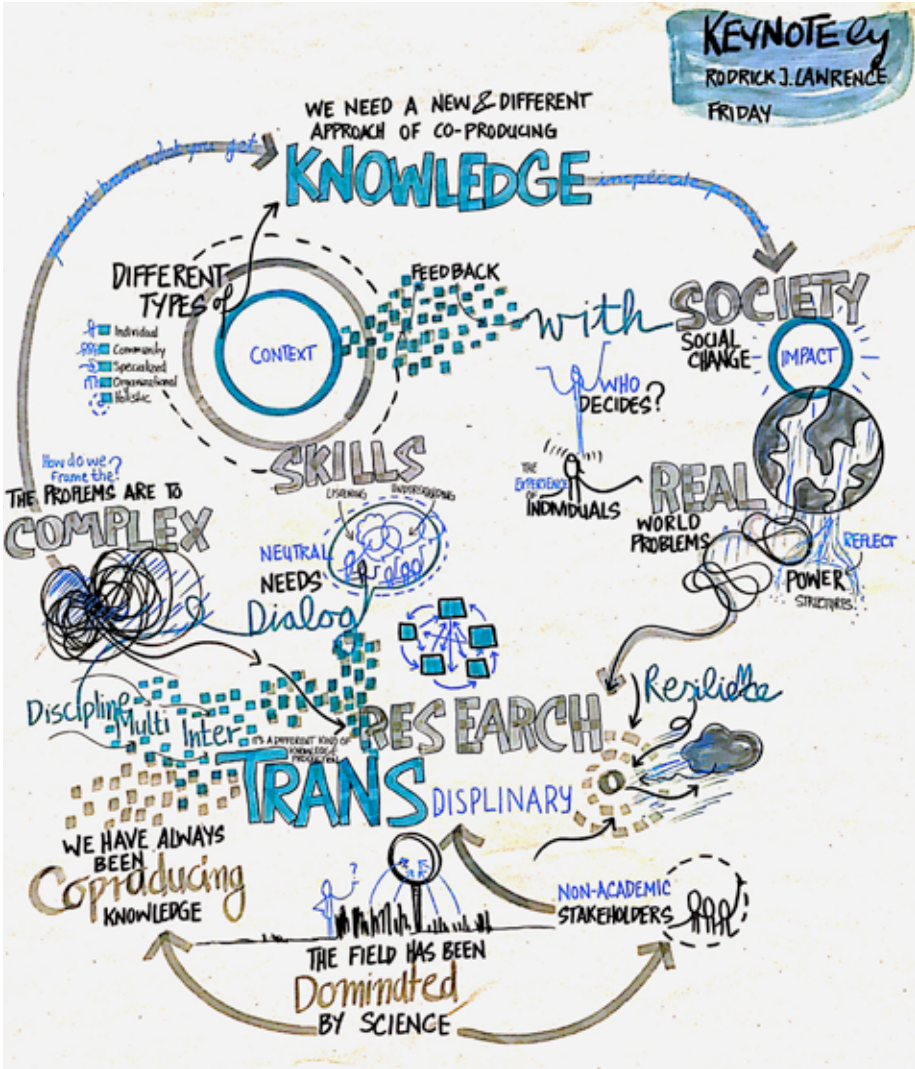
What impressions will you take away from this conference?
